- ◆ Making recommendations to the staffs and boards of the water districts about additional activities that will make our foothills the gold standard of water conservationists.

Experience: None needed. We are looking for enthusiastic, involved people in the community who can spare a few hours each week. We will train you, including tours of local water facilities, and we will provide all the materials you need including identifying polo shirts and caps.
